

## Rules of Procedure

### 9<sup>th</sup> Photo Contest for Youth in the Mediterranean

#### *“Fostering sustainable environments”*

#### 1. Who can participate

This competition is open to youth participants between the ages of 18 and 30 who live within the 26 countries whose National Societies form the Mediterranean Conference<sup>1</sup>.

#### 2. How to participate

- **Number of photos:** Each participant can submit up to three photos, (only one of the three will be selected for the prizes.
- **Application:** To be eligible for the competition, **each photo** must be accompanied by a **description form (attached)** including the copyright permission for the photo.
- **Documents to be sent:** The photos, the description forms and the copyright.
- **Closing date:** The photos should be submitted by the **2<sup>nd</sup> April** at 24:00h (Europe/Madrid GMT)
- **Where to send them:** All documents and photos must be emailed to: [photosmed@cruzroja.es](mailto:photosmed@cruzroja.es)

#### 3. Technical Requirements to participate

The photos must be the original version and submitted unedited, unpublished, and have the following characteristics:

- Format: .jpg or .jpeg
- Photo: in colour or black and white

- Original dimensions: 13x18 cm or equivalent, vertical or horizontal snapshots
- Size: 2 MB (2000 Kb) maximum
- File: Each file name should follow the following formula:  
« Last name - first name - title.jpg/.jpeg »

#### **4. Selection of photos and prizes**

The jury will be set up in order to select the best photos based on:

- Adequate relation of photos to the theme proposed
- Artistic quality of the photo
- Originality
- Ability to raise awareness on the fundamental importance of Youth Engagement

12 photos will be selected and exhibited in the RC/RC Mediterranean Youth Camp Atlantis XIII, which will be held in Malaga (Spain) from the 8<sup>th</sup> to the 15<sup>th</sup> of July 2018.

The first and second prizes will consist in an invitation to the 14<sup>th</sup> edition of the Youth Camp Atlantis. Travel and accommodations will be covered by the organization.

A selection of the best photos, including the winning photos and those in the exhibit, will be published on the CCM Facebook page.

#### **5. Restrictions & Conditions**

- Each participant is free to approach the theme of sustainable environments considering youth in the multiple roles of leaders, volunteers or beneficiaries, in line with the IFRC Y.E.S (*Youth Engagement Strategy*)<sup>2</sup>. Each person may work on this theme from one or many of the integrated related subjects.
- The author of the photo/s holds all responsibility concerning the people and objects he/she has photographed.
- All photos with racist, xenophobic, discriminatory or proselytizing connotations as well as those that threaten, deceive, slander, denigrate, are aggressive, vulgar, violent, obscene or pornographic will be excluded from the competition.
- It is also important to add that the photos have to follow the Code of Conduct on Images and Messages of the European NGOs, which you can find attached.

## **6. Rights and responsibilities of the authors of the photos**

- The CCM will have the right to use the photos taken by the participant for their print, reproduction, dissemination, distribution, exhibition, publication, advertising actions, etc., in order to fulfil its institutional objectives.
- The CCM will not use these photos in a context other than these objectives, and must in every occasion name the author of the photos. It remains authorized to use them in all media (television, cinema, Internet) or supports (posters, websites, booklets, etc...).
- The author of the photo holds all responsibility concerning the people and objects he/she has photographed.
